



Are you ready for the new Workplace Health and Safety requirements in 2012?

As a Person Conducting a Business or Undertaking (PCBU), as of 1 January 2012, there are new regulations under the Queensland *Work Health and Safety Act 2011* (WHS Act) you need to be aware of.

What does this mean for you?

The WHS Act requires all PCBUs to ensure the health and safety of workers, so far as is reasonably practicable. Workers include volunteers, contractors and contractors' workers.

The key changes are for PCBUs, with the main focus on 10 key areas listed below:

- Training, information and instruction
- General working environment
- First aid
- Emergency plans
- Personal protective equipment
- Remote or isolated work
- Managing risks from contaminants
- Hazardous atmospheres
- Storage of ignition sources
- Falling objects
